How often is this information updated?

This information is typically updated daily (except for weekends and holidays).

How do I determine the category type for Terminal Distributors of Dangerous Drugs?

To determine the category type of terminal distributors, use the "Subcategory" column of the list, as follows:

"02" = Category II License: This licensee may possess, have custody or control of, and distribute prescription drugs (including medical oxygen and other medical grade gases) that are not controlled substances.

"12" = Limited Category II License: This licensee may only possess, have custody or control of, and distribute prescription drugs (including medical grade gases) that are not controlled substances approved by a Medical Director. "03" = Category III License: This licensee may possess, have custody or control of, and distribute prescription drugs, including controlled substances contained in Schedules II, III, IV, or V.

"13" = Limited Category III License: This licensee may only possess, have custody or control of, and distribute prescription drugs, including controlled substances approved by a Medical Director. How do I determine the category type for Wholesale Distributors of Dangerous Drugs?

"02" = Category II License: This licensee may possess, have custody or control of, and sell prescription drugs (including medical oxygen and other medical grade gases) that are not controlled substances.



"03" = Category III License: This licensee may possess, have custody or control of, and sell prescription drugs, including controlled substances contained in Schedules II, III, IV, or V.

Can I rely on this data to verify licensure prior to sale or purchase?

Yes. A wholesale or terminal distributor of dangerous drugs may utilize this licensing information to verify licensure status prior to sale or purchase. The spreadsheet must be accessed on a weekly basis to ensure the most up-to-date licensure status.
