



CONTINUING EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES IN CULTURAL COMPETENCY FOR PHARMACY PROFESSIONALS

Although it can be defined in numerous ways, cultural competency in pharmacy practice is generally a complex integration of knowledge, attitudes, and skills that promotes effective communication and appropriate interactions with patients from various ethnic and/or cultural groups.

Cultural competency can foster a greater understanding and appreciation of diverse patient populations, giving pharmacy professionals additional information and insight to enrich patient care. The skills developed with cultural competency allow healthcare providers to understand and respect a patient's cultural identity.

The Board has developed the following guidance to assist pharmacy professionals in locating existing continuing education courses addressing cultural competency. While there is no requirement to complete continuing education relating to this subject, the Board encourages its licensees to consider these important learning opportunities.
