



## **JURISPRUDENCE CONTINUING EDUCATION (CE) REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

**UPDATED 1-05-2016**

Pursuant to Rule 4729-7-02(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code, at least 0.3 C.E.U.s (3 hours) of the total C.E.U.s required for the renewal of a pharmacist identification card must be in pharmacy jurisprudence. Pharmacists licensed with the Board who do not practice in Ohio and have met the mandatory continuing education requirements of another state where they hold a current license to practice pharmacy are not required to complete Ohio Board approved jurisprudence if they sign the waiver statement as stated in Rule 4729-7-02(F) of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Effective January 15, 2016, pharmacists have two options to meet the current requirement that they obtain 0.3 C.E.U.s of pharmacy jurisprudence per CE reporting cycle. These two options are:

1. [A.C.P.E.](#) law programs as identified by A.C.P.E numbering convention "03"; or
2. If provided by an in-state provider of continuing education, Board approved continuing pharmacy education programs that deal with current laws, rules, and regulations dealing with the practice of pharmacy and the recent changes that have occurred to those laws, rules and regulations. **NOTE: A.C.P.E. law programs successfully completed prior to January 15, 2016 and during the C.E.U. reporting dates will count towards meeting jurisprudence requirements.**

It is the responsibility of the pharmacist to verify that he/she has obtained pharmacy jurisprudence that meets the requirements in OAC 4729-7-01 prior to attesting that their C.E. requirements have been met.

Be sure to keep this certificate to use if you are audited. We are not able to upload successful completion of the exam to CPE monitor. Please note: Do not mail any quizzes to the Board office. We will not hand-process nor will we mail a certificate to you.
