Please note: You must be able to document that you meet the training criteria for each immunization that you will be administering (4729-5-36). Effective March 19, 2015, changes to Ohio's pharmacist immunization laws may require you to complete additional coursework in order to provide the full range of immunizations authorized under the law.
