

THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

VS

WARDELL GOOCH

THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS WARDELL GOOCH, DOCKET 6-27-1 WAS CONSIDERED PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729. AND 119., OF THE REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

1. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS WARDELL GOOCH DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A) OHIO REVISED CODE IN THAT HE WAS FOUND GUILTY OF A FELONY BY THE HONORABLE WILLIAM K. THOMAS, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, ON FEBRUARY 16, 1978, TO WIT: OMISSION OF MATERIAL INFORMATION FROM RECORDS, IN VIOLATION OF TITLE 21, SECTION 843(a)(4), UNITED STATES CODE, 2 COUNTS.
2. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16, REVISED CODE:
"THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 TO 119.13 OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE, SUSPEND OR REFUSE TO GRANT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER, OR MAY IMPOSE A MONETARY PENALTY OR FORFEITURE NOT TO EXCEED IN SEVERITY ANY FINE DESIGNATED UNDER THE REVISED CODE FOR A SIMILAR OFFENSE, IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FINDS A PHARMACIST:
(A) GUILTY OF A FELONY."
3. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS THAT WARDELL GOOCH WAS CONVICTED OF A FELONY VIOLATION: TO WIT: OMISSION OF MATERIAL INFORMATION FROM RECORDS AND THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS THAT MR. GOOCH IS GUILTY OF SUCH OFFENSE.
4. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY HEREBY REVOKES THE IDENTIFICATION CARD OF WARDELL GOOCH, EFFECTIVE MARCH 15, 1979.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
