THE MATTER OF JACQUITA GRIMES WALKER CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON DECEMBER 2, 1987. MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

- (1) On October 23, 1987, Jacquita Grimes Walker was notified by letter of her right to a hearing, her rights in such hearing, and her right to submit her contentions in writing.
- (2) As demonstrated by letter dated November 2, 1987, Jacquita Grimes Walker received the letter of October 23, 1987 informing her of the allegations regarding the late renewal of her license, and her rights.
- (3) Jacquita Grimes Walker submitted a letter, received November 9, 1987, setting forth her position and contentions in writing, and has not requested a hearing in this matter.
- (4) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Jacquita Grimes Walker failed to renew her identification card on the fifteenth day of September, as required by Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, for 1988, when she did not renew until October 9, 1987.
- (5) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Jacquita Grimes Walker failed to renew her identification card on the fifteenth day of September, as required by Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, for 1977, when she did not renew until October 21, 1976.
- (6) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Jacquita Grimes Walker failed to renew her identification card on the fifteenth day of September, as required by Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, for 1975, when she did not renew until October 3, 1974.

- (7) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Jacquita Grimes Walker did dispense and sell dangerous drugs while not being a registered pharmacist during the lapsed dates of her pharmacist license, in violation of the provisions of Section 4729.28 of the Revised Code.

Conclusion Of Law

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (4) through (7) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes willful violations of the provisions of Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following actions concerning the pharmacist identification card held by Jacquita Grimes Walker:

(A) The State Board of Pharmacy hereby imposes a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

(B) Further, the Board suspends four hundred dollars of the five hundred dollar monetary penalty imposed above provided that Jacquita Grimes Walker:

- (1) does not violate the drug laws of the state of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government; and
- (2) abides by the rules of the State Board of Pharmacy.

The one hundred dollar (\$100.00) monetary penalty that was not suspended in paragraph (B) above is due and owing within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this Order. The monetary penalty should be made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Ohio" and mailed to the State Board of Pharmacy, 65 S. Front Street, Room 504, Columbus, Ohio 43266-0320, with the enclosed form.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

It is hereby certified by this Board that the above language is a copy of the Order entered upon its journal in this case.

Section 119.12 of the Revised Code authorizes an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal may be taken to the court of common pleas in the county in which your place of business is located or to said court of the county in which you reside. If you do not have a place of business in Ohio and are not a resident of Ohio, you may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio.

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Order of the Board

Such an appeal, setting forth the order appealed from and the grounds of the appeal, must be commenced by the filing of a Notice of Appeal with the State Board of Pharmacy and the appropriate court within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this notice and in accordance with the requirements of Section 119.12 of the Revised Code.
