THE MATTER OF DARRELL H. GOFORTH, DOCKET NO. 6-146-1, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 119. AND 4729. OF THE REVISED CODE ON MONDAY, JUNE 23, 1986. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Darrell H. Goforth did willfully, knowingly, and intentionally violate Section 465.015(2)(c), Florida Statutes, between January, 1983 and September, 1983, to wit: approximately 900ml of Tussionex, a prescription drug and Schedule III controlled substance, was dispensed without a prescription.
- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Darrell H. Goforth did willfully, knowingly, and intentionally violate Section 465.015(2)(c), Florida Statutes, between January, 1983 and September, 1983, to wit: approximately two pints of Tussionex, a prescription drug and Schedule III controlled substance, was dispensed without a prescription.
- (3) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Darrell H. Goforth sold Tussionex, a prescription drug, without having received a prescription for the drug.
- (4) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) through (3) above, had it occurred in Ohio, would constitute willfully violating the provisions of Chapters 2925., 3715., 3719., and 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code.

Conclusions Of Law

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) through (3) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes gross immorality.
- (2) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) through (3) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes dishonesty and unprofessional conduct in the practice of pharmacy.

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Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the foregoing Findings Of Fact and Conclusions Of Law, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the pharmacist identification card held by Darrell H. Goforth, No. 03-1-09723, for 12 months. Further, the Board suspends the suspension on condition that Darrell H. Goforth:

- (A) does not violate any drug laws of the state of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government; and
- (B) abides by the rules of the State Board of Pharmacy.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
