

THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

VS

DALE N. KOHLREISER

The matter of the State Board of Pharmacy versus Dale N. Kohlreiser, Docket 6-31-1 was considered pursuant to Chapters 4729. and 119., of the Revised Code. After consideration of the evidence adduced, motion was made and recorded the following order be adopted:

ORDER

1. The State Board of Pharmacy finds Dale N. Kohlreiser did violate Section 4729.16(A) Ohio Revised Code in that he was found guilty of a felony by the Court of Common Pleas, Gallia County, on October 5, 1978, to wit; theft of drugs, a violation of Section 2925.21 of the Ohio Revised Code.

2. The State Board of Pharmacy finds under Section 4729.16, Revised Code:

"The State Board of Pharmacy, after notice and hearing in accordance with Sections 119.01 to 119.13 of the Revised Code, may revoke, suspend or refuse to grant an identification card or renewal identification card under this chapter, or may impose a monetary penalty or forfeiture not to exceed in severity any fine designated under the Revised Code for a similar offense, if a majority of the members of the Board finds a pharmacist:

(A) Guilty of a felony."

3. The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Dale N. Kohlreiser was convicted of a felony violation, to wit; theft of drugs and the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Mr. Kohlreiser is guilty of such offense.

4. The State Board of Pharmacy hereby revokes the identification card of Dale N. Kohlreiser, effective immediately.

Section 4729.16 Ohio Revised Code provides:

"Any individual whose identification card is revoked, suspended, or refused, shall return his identification card and certificate of registration to the offices of the State Board of Pharmacy within ten days after receipt of notice of such action.

This order was approved by a vote of the State Board of Pharmacy.
