

THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

VS

JOSEPH STEPHEN VANN

THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS JOSEPH STEPHEN VANN, DOCKET 6-28-1, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729. AND 119., REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

1. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS JOSEPH STEPHEN VANN DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A) OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE WAS FOUND GUILTY OF A FELONY BY THE HONORABLE RALPH A. HILL, JUDGE OF THE CLERMONT COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT TO WIT: THEFT OF DRUGS (SUBLIMAZE) A VIOLATION OF SECTION 2925.21(A) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.
2. FURTHER THAT JOSEPH STEPHEN VANN VIOLATED SECTION 2925.21(A) OHIO REVISED CODE IN THAT HE COMMITTED THE OFFENSE OF THEFT OF DRUGS TO WIT: FENTANYL, MORPHINE, ANILERIDINE AND HYDROMORPHONE BETWEEN THE DATES OF MAY 2, 1977 AND SEPTEMBER 12, 1977.
3. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16 REVISED CODE:
"THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 TO 119.13 OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE, SUSPEND OR REFUSE TO GRANT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER, OR MAY IMPOSE A MONETARY PENALTY OR FORFEITURE NOT TO EXCEED IN SEVERITY ANY FINE DESIGNATED UNDER THE REVISED CODE FOR A SIMILAR OFFENSE, IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FINDS A PHARMACIST:
(A) GUILTY OF A FELONY."
4. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS THAT MR. VANN WAS CONVICTED OF A FELONY, TO WIT: THEFT OF DRUGS (SUBLIMAZE) BY THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS AND THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS THAT MR. VANN IS GUILTY OF THAT OFFENSE.
5. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS THAT MR. VANN IS GUILTY OF THEFT OF DRUGS, TO WIT: FENTANYL, MORPHINE, ANILERIDINE AND HYDROMORPHONE.
6. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY HEREBY REVOKES THE IDENTIFICATION CARD OF JOSEPH STEPHEN VANN, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
