THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

VS

JOHNNIE L. HANNA

The matter of the State Board of Pharmacy versus Mr. Johnnie L. Hanna, Docket No. 6-12-3, was heard pursuant to Chapters 4729 and 119, Revised Code. After consideration of the evidence adduced, motion was made and recorded the following order be adopted:

ORDER

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy finds Mr. Johnnie L. Hanna is guilty of charges A and B of the citation and did violate Section 3715.64(A), (1), Revised Code, one time and Section 3715.64(A), (9), (d), Revised Code, one time.
- (2) The State Board of Pharmacy finds Mr. Johnnie L. Hanna did violate Section 4729.16(C), Revised Code, in that he willfully violated more than one time any of the provisions of Section 3715.52 to 3715.72, of the Revised Code.
- (3) The State Board of Pharmacy finds under Section 4729.16, Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy, after notice and hearing in accordance with Sections 119.01 to 119.13, inclusive, of the Revised Code, may revoke, suspend, or refuse to grant an identification card or renewal identification card under this Chapter, or may impose a monetary penalty or forfeiture not to exceed in severity and fine designated under the Revised Code for a similar offense, if a majority of the members of the Board find a Pharmacist or Pharmacy Intern:
 - (C) Guilty of willfully violating more than one time any of the provisions of Sections 3715.52 to 3715.72, of the Revised Code.
- (4) The State Board of Pharmacy fines Mr. Johnnie L. Hanna \$100 each on charges A and B of the citation for a total of \$200.
- (5) The State Board of Pharmacy suspends the \$200 fine.

This order was approved by a roll call vote of the State Board of Pharmacy.

Motion carried.

So ordered.

It is hereby certified by this Board that the above language is a copy of the order entered upon its journal in this case.

Section 119.12, Ohio Revised Code, authorizes an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal must be taken to the Court of Common Pleas in the county in which your place of business is located or to said court of the county in which you reside. Such an appeal setting forth the Order appealed from and the grounds of the appeal must be commenced by the filing of a Notice of Appeal with the State Board of Pharmacy and the appropriate court within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this notice and in accordance with the requirements of Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.
