THE MATTER OF THOMAS A. AVELLONE, DOCKET NO. D-861218-075, CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 13, 1987. MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

- (1) On December 18, 1986, Thomas E. Avellone, R.Ph. No. 03-1-13072, was notified by letter of his right to a hearing, his rights in such hearing, and his right to submit his position, contentions, and arguments in writing.
- (2) As demonstrated by return receipt of January 5, 1986, Mr. Avellone received the letter of December 18, 1986 informing him of his rights and that the evidence of continuing pharmacy education submitted by him during the audit was insufficient proof of compliance with the rules of the Board.
- (3) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Thomas E. Avellone has not requested a hearing in this matter.
- (4) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Mr. Avellone has not submitted the required proof of continuing pharmacy education as reported by him for renewal of his pharmacist identification card.
- (5) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Mr. Avellone has not continued his pharmacy education in accordance with Chapter 4729-7 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

Conclusion Of Law

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (4) and (5) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes failure to meet the requirements for a renewal identification card as set forth in Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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Pursuant to Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the foregoing Findings Of Fact and Conclusion Of Law, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby denies the issuance of a renewal application for the 1987-1988 licensure year to Thomas E. Avellone.

Accordingly, Thomas E. Avellone may not legally engage in the practice of pharmacy in Ohio after September 15, 1987.
