FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that Lori S. Rogers was licensed as a pharmacist on April 22, 1983, and has been practicing pharmacy in this state at Kaiser and Wells, Inc., 5 West College Street, Oberlin, Ohio.
- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Kaiser and Wells, Inc. did, on or about March 16, 1988, fail to keep a record of all controlled substances received or dispensed as required by Section 3719.07(G)(2) of the Ohio Revised

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Code, to wit: a record was not kept to indicate the name and place of residence of each person to whom controlled substances were dispensed, the kind and quantity of such controlled substances dispensed to each person, the date such controlled substances were dispensed to each person, and the name and address of the practitioner prescribing drugs to the person to whom they were dispensed.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraph (2) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes minor violations of the provisions of Chapters 3719. and 4729. of the Revised Code, and that the public interest is adequately served by a notice and warning as provided in Sections 3719.18(B) and 4729.25(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

ORDER

Pursuant to Sections 3719.18 and 4729.25 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby REPRIMANDS Lori S. Rogers, R.Ph. with the following stipulations:

(A) That legally required information be secured and recorded on all prescriptions including those issued for controlled substances.

(B) That proper procedures be followed for the legal distribution of dangerous drugs including the wholesale sale of controlled substances to practitioners.

(C) That more caution be exercised when dispensing controlled substances and that careful documentation of interaction with prescribers pertaining to questionable prescriptions be retained with the prescription records. More caution should be exercised when reviewing the dispensing frequency of controlled substances.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
