### INTRODUCTION

THE MATTER OF LESLIE ANN MAUERSBERG CAME TO HEARING ON OCTOBER 25, 1994, BEFORE THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: PAUL F. LAMPING, R.Ph. (presiding); ROBERT B. CAVENDISH, R.Ph.; AMONTE B. LITTLEJOHN, R.Ph.; JOSEPH J. MASLAK, R.Ph.; WAYNE C. MILLER, R.Ph.; SUZANNE L. NEUBER, R.Ph.; AND NICHOLAS R. REPKE, PUBLIC MEMBER.

LESLIE ANN MAUERSBERG WAS REPRESENTED BY DAVID W. GRAUER, AND THE STATE OF OHIO WAS REPRESENTED BY AVA SERRANO, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

After having heard the testimony, considered the evidence, observed the demeanor of the witnesses, and weighed their credibility, the State Board of Pharmacy finds the following to be fact:

- (1) Records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that Leslie Ann Mauersberg was originally licensed in the state of Ohio on October 31, 1988, pursuant to examination, and is currently licensed to practice pharmacy in Ohio.
- (2) Leslie Ann Mauersberg did, on or about November 1, 1991, intentionally make and/or knowingly possess a false or forged prescription, to wit: Leslie Ann Mauersberg created and maintained on file at the pharmacy prescription number 426597, which had originally been written as a refill for prescription number 426565 for the schedule II controlled substance Dilaudid. Such conduct is in violation of Section 2925.23(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (3) Leslie Ann Mauersberg did, on or about November 6, 1991, knowingly possess a false or forged prescription, to wit: Leslie Ann Mauersberg maintained on file at the pharmacy prescription number 426659, as a refill of prescription number 426565, which had originally been written by Nelson Kraus, not a practitioner properly licensed to prescribe controlled substances, for the schedule II controlled substance Dilaudid. Such conduct is in violation of Section 2925.23(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (2) and (3) of the Findings of Fact constitute being guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of pharmacy as provided in Division (A)(2) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (2) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (2) and (3) of the Findings of Fact constitute being guilty of willfully violating, conspiring to violate, attempting to violate, or aiding and abetting the violation of any of the provisions of Sections 3715.52 to 3715.72 or Chapter 2925., 3719., or 4729. of the Revised Code as provided in Division (A)(5) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

#### ACTION OF THE BOARD

Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following actions in the matter of Leslie Ann Mauersberg:

- (A) On the basis of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby places the identification card, No. 03-1-17558, held by Leslie Ann Mauersberg on probation for six months effective as of the date of the mailing of this Order. The terms of probation are as follows:
  - (1) Leslie Ann Mauersberg must not violate the drug laws of the state of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government;
  - (2) Leslie Ann Mauersberg must abide by the rules of the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy; and
  - (3) Leslie Ann Mauersberg must comply with the terms of this Order.

The Board may at any time revoke probation for cause, modify the conditions of probation, and reduce or extend the period of probation. At any time during this

period of probation, the Board may revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
