THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS MR. ROLAND E. LANDRUM, DOCKET NO. 6-15-3, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729 AND 119, REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

1. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS MR. ROLAND E. LANDRUM IS GUILTY OF VIOLATION SECTION 4729.16(A), REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE IS QUILTY OF ALL CHARGES CONTAINED IN THE CITATION.
2. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY SUSPENDS THE RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD OF ROLAND E. LANDRUM FOR TWO YEARS EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 1976.
3. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY PROVIDES ROLAND E. LANDRUM OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING AFTER ONE YEAR TO SHOW CAUSE WHY HIS IDENTIFICATION CARD SHOULD BE RENEWED.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
