THE MATTER OF SUSAN LEE BRUNNER, R.Ph., DOCKET NO. 6-57-2, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 119. AND 4729. OF THE REVISED CODE ON MARCH 23, 1983. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

Findings of Fact

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Susan Lee Brunner did, on or about March 26, 1980 at Easterday Pharmacy, Inc., 1675 S. Arch, Alliance, Ohio 44601, dispense 30 capsules of Ionamin 30mg, a Schedule IV controlled substance, without a written or oral prescription given by a practitioner; in violation of the federal narcotic law as defined in Section 4729.02 of the Revised Code, and Sections 2925.03(A)(1), 3715.52(L), 3715.64(A)(13)(b), and 3719.05(A) of the Revised Code.
- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Susan Lee Brunner did, on or about March 26, 1980 at Easterday Pharmacy, Inc., 1675 S. Arch, Alliance, Ohio 44601, dispense 15 capsules of Ionamin 15mg, a Schedule IV controlled substance, without a written or oral prescription given by a practitioner; in violation of the federal narcotic law as defined in Section 4729.02 of the Revised Code, and Sections 2925.03(A)(1), 3715.52(L), 3715.64(A)(13)(b), and 3719.05(A) of the Revised Code.

Conclusions of Law

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of the Findings of Fact constitutes willful violations of more than one time any of the provisions of Chapters 2925., 3715., 3719., and 4729. of the Revised Code.

Pursuant to division (C) of Section 4729.16 of the Revised Code, and the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following disciplinary action against the registered pharmacist license of Susan Lee Brunner, R.Ph. No. 03-20-9266:

- (A) On the basis of the Conclusion of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the registered pharmacist identification card of Susan Lee Brunner for 24 months.

(B) Further, the Board suspends the 24-month suspension on condition that Susan Lee Brunner:

(1) take and successfully complete the Jurisprudence examination when it is offered in June, 1983;

(2) not violate any drug laws of the State of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government; and,

(3) abides by the rules of the State Board of Pharmacy.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
