DANIEL EDWARD OSLOWSKI

THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS DANIEL EDWARD OSLOWSKI, DOCKET NO. 6-40-2, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729. AND 119. OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Daniel Edward Oslowski did on one or more occasions between August 1, 1979 and December 4, 1979 at Revco Discount Drug Store, Inc., 4271 Mayfield Road, S. Euclid Ohio, obtain one hundred 50 mg. Demerol tablets and two hundred Demerol 100 mg. tablets which are dangerous drugs and controlled substances by committing a theft offense, in that he did, with purpose to deprive the owner of the aforementioned drugs, knowingly obtain said drugs beyond the scope of the express or implied consent of the owner or person authorized to give consent as charged in the citation letter. Said conduct being prohibited by Section 2925.21(A) of the Ohio Revised Code.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that the conduct set forth in paragraph (1) of the Findings of Fact constitutes gross immorality.
- (2) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that the conduct set forth in paragraph (1) of the Findings of Fact also constitutes willful violations of more than one time of a provision of Chapter 2925. of the Revised Code.

PURSUANT TO SECTION 4729.16 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND THE FOREGOING FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY TAKES THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST THE REGISTERED PHARMACIST LICENSE OF DANIEL EDWARD OSLOWSKI:

- (A) FOR VIOLATIONS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THE CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY HEREBY SUSPENDS THE REGISTERED PHARMACIST IDENTIFICATION CARD OF DANIEL EDWARD OSLOWSKI FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND FURTHER SUSPENDS THE TWO-YEAR SUSPENSION ON CONDITION THAT MR. OSLOWSKI SHALL NOT VIOLATE ANY DRUG LAWS OF THE STATE OF OHIO AND ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
- (B) FOR VIOLATIONS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THE CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY HEREBY FINES DANIEL EDWARD OSLOWSKI THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS, SAID FINE PAYABLE ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31, 1980.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
