THE MATTER OF TERRYE YVONNE THOMPSON CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON DECEMBER 14, 1989 AS A RESULT OF THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD BY HEARING OFFICER AND BOARD MEMBER NORMAN LEIBOW. FOLLOWING CONSIDERATION OF THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION, THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE HEARING, AND EVIDENCE ADDUCED AT THE HEARING, MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

### ORDER

#### Findings Of Fact

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Findings Of Fact set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Norman Leibow, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that Terrye Yvonne Thompson was initially registered as a pharmacist in Ohio pursuant to reciprocity on June 25, 1979, and has been practicing pharmacy since that date at the Cleveland Metro Hospital, 3395 Scranton Road, Cleveland, Ohio. Records further indicate that her license to practice pharmacy has lapsed from September 16, 1980 to September 19, 1980, from September 16, 1981 to November 2, 1981, and from September 16, 1988 to September 23, 1988.

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- (2) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Terrye Yvonne Thompson did, or or about September 19, 1988, compound, dispense, or sell dangerous drugs while not being a registered pharmacist or a pharmacy intern, to wit: after allowing her license to lapse and prior to its renewal, Terrye Yvonne Thompson dispensed 1 tablet of Warfarin 5mg, a dangerous drug. Such conduct is in violation of Section 4729.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

#### Conclusion Of Law

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Conclusion Of Law set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Norman Leibow, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes willfully violating the provisions of Section 4729.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

#### Action Of The Board

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the recommendation for action set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Norman Leibow. Therefore, pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby imposes a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

Further, the State Board of Pharmacy suspends four hundred dollars (\$400.00) of the five hundred dollar monetary penalty imposed above.

The one hundred dollar monetary penalty that was not suspended above is due and owing within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this Order. The monetary penalty should be made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Ohio" and mailed to the State Board of Pharmacy, 77 S. High Street, 17th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43266-0320, with the enclosed form.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

MOTION CARRIED.

It is hereby certified by this Board that the above language is a copy of the Order entered upon its journal in this case.

Section 119.12 of the Revised Code authorizes an appeal from this Order. Such an appeal may be taken to the court of common pleas in the county in which your place of business is located or to said court of the county in which you reside. If you do not have a place of business in Ohio and are not a resident of Ohio, you may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas in Franklin County, Ohio.

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
