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CONSENT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

This Consent Agreement is entered into by and between Elaine Adams Frank and the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy, a state agency charged with enforcing the Pharmacy Practice Act and Dangerous Drug Distribution Act, Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code.

Elaine Adams Frank enters into this Agreement being fully informed of her rights afforded under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues contained herein.

Elaine Adams Frank is knowingly and voluntarily acknowledging that, in order to obviate the need to conduct an administrative hearing to consider possible disciplinary sanctions against her license to practice pharmacy in the state of Ohio, this Agreement is entered into on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions, and understandings:

- (1) The Ohio State Board of Pharmacy is empowered by Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code to suspend, revoke, place on probation, refuse to grant or renew an identification card, or impose a monetary penalty on the license holder for violation of any of the enumerated grounds.
- (2) Elaine Adams Frank was notified by letter, on or about March 28, 1994, pursuant to Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, of her right to a hearing, her rights in such hearing, and her right to submit her contentions in writing.
- (3) Elaine Adams Frank was originally licensed to practice pharmacy in the state of Ohio on April 29, 1987, pursuant to reciprocity; and her identification card has been lapsed since September 15, 1994.
- (4) Elaine Adams Frank has not continued her pharmacy education in accordance with Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code and Rules 4729-7-01 through 4729-7-07 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
