### INTRODUCTION

THE MATTER OF NAJIB M. SUFI CAME TO HEARING ON SEPTEMBER 21, 1995, BEFORE THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: PAUL F. LAMPING, R.Ph. (presiding); ROBERT B. CAVENDISH, R.Ph.; JOHN L. HANNA, R.Ph.; AMONTE B. LITTLEJOHN, R.Ph.; WAYNE C. MILLER, R.Ph.; SUZANNE L. NEUBER, R.Ph.; RUTH A. PLANT, R.Ph.; AND NICHOLAS R. REPKE, PUBLIC MEMBER.

NAJIB M. SUFI WAS NOT REPRESENTED BY COUNSEL, AND THE STATE OF OHIO WAS REPRESENTED BY LAWRENCE D. PRATT, ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

After having heard the testimony, considered the evidence, observed the demeanor of the witnesses, and weighed their credibility, the State Board of Pharmacy finds the following to be fact:

- (1) Records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that on or about August 14, 1995, Najib M. Sufi submitted an application for transfer of his pharmaceutical licensure.
- (2) Najib M. Sufi was, on or about October 1, 1984, disciplined by the state of California, Board of Pharmacy, Department of Consumer Affairs, for having committed acts constituting "unprofessional conduct."

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraph (2) of the Findings of Fact constitute being guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of pharmacy as provided in Division (A)(2) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

#### ACTION OF THE BOARD

Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby takes the following actions in the matter of Najib M. Sufi:

- (A) The State Board of Pharmacy hereby approves the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy Official Application for Transfer of Pharmaceutical Licensure of Najib M. Sufi. The Board will allow Mr. Sufi to sit for the Reciprocity Hearing on October 17, 1995.
- (B) On the basis of the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby places the pharmacist identification card, No. 03-2-21388, when issued to Najib M. Sufi on probation for two years effective October 17, 1995. The terms of probation are as follows:
  - (1) Najib M. Sufi must not violate the drug laws of the state of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government.

- (2) Najib M. Sufi must abide by the rules of the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy.
- (3) Najib M. Sufi must comply with the terms of this Order.

The Board may at any time revoke probation for cause, modify the conditions of probation, and reduce or extend the period of probation. At any time during this period of probation, the Board may revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
