THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS WILLIAM K. KUTLER, DOCKET 6-24-2 WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729. AND 119., REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

1. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS WILLIAM K. KUTLER DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A) OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE WAS FOUND GUILTY OF A FELONY BY THE HONORABLE HARRY A. HANNA, COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO TO WIT: OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE, A VIOLATION OF SECTION 2921.32 OHIO REVISED CODE.

2. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16 REVISED CODE:

"THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 TO 119.13 OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE, SUSPEND, OR REFUSE TO GRANT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER, IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FIND A PHARMACIST:

(a) GUILTY OF A FELONY"

3. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY HEREBY SUSPENDS THE IDENTIFICATION CARD OF WILLIAM K. KUTLER FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 1978.

4. THE BOARD SUSPENDS THE SUSPENSION.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
