KATHERINE B. REEDY, R.Ph.

THE MATTER OF KATHERINE B. REEDY, DOCKET NO. 6-142-2, CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 4, 1985. MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

- (1) On August 20, 1985, Katherine B. Reedy, R.Ph. No. 03-3-03827, was notified by letter of her right to a hearing, her rights in such hearing, and her right to submit her contentions in writing.
- (2) As demonstrated by return receipt of August 23, 1985, Katherine B. Reedy received the letter of August 20, 1985 informing her of her failure to continue her pharmacy education and her rights.
- (3) On September 9, 1985, the Board received a letter setting forth her position and contentions in writing.

Conclusion Of Law

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that Katherine B. Reedy did not continue her pharmacy education as required by Chapter 4729. of the Revised Code and therefore does not qualify for renewal of her identification card to practice pharmacy in Ohio.

Pursuant to Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy hereby denies Katherine B. Reedy's application for renewal of her pharmacist identification card to actively practice pharmacy in Ohio.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
