Findings Of Fact

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that records of the Board indicate that Abraham Poleyeff was originally licensed in the state of Ohio on July 18, 1949, pursuant to examination, and was summarily suspended by this Board on June 11, 1991, pursuant to the mandates of Section 3719.121(c) of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Abraham Poleyeff was, on or about June 7, 1991, found guilty in the Common Pleas Court of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, of Aggravated Trafficking and Illegal Processing of Drug Documents, felonies of the second and fourth degrees.

- (3) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Abraham Poleyeff did, on or about the following dates, sell a controlled substance in an amount equal to or greater than bulk but less than three times bulk when the conduct was not in accordance with Chapters 3719. and 4729. of the Revised Code, to wit: Abraham Poleyeff sold the following Schedule II controlled substance, in the following instances when ordered by physician C. B. Johnson, M.D., not for a legitimate medical purpose, for patient Laura Brown:

The patient was dispensed, from July 29, 1985 through September 23, 1986, a 421 day time period, 390 tablets of Desoxyn 15mg, and was dispensed a total of 420 tablets. Such conduct is in violation of Section 2925.03(A)(5) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Conclusions Of Law

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (2) through (30) of the Findings Of Fact constitute being guilty of a felony and gross immorality as provided in Division (A)(1) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (2) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (2) through (30) of the Findings Of Fact constitute being guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of pharmacy as provided in Division (A)(2) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- (3) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (3) through (30) of the Findings Of Fact constitute being guilty of willfully violating, conspiring to violate, attempting to violate, or aiding and abetting the violation of any of the provisions of Sections 3715.52 to 3715.72 or Chapter 2925., 3719., or 4729. of the Revised Code as provided in Division (A)(5) of Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Action Of The Board

Pursuant to Section 3719.121 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby removes the Summary Suspension Order, Docket No. D-910611-078, issued June 11, 1991.

Pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following actions concerning the pharmacist license, No. 03-3-04359, held by Abraham Poleyeff:

(A) On the basis of paragraphs (1), (2), and (3) of the Conclusions Of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the pharmacist identification card held by Abraham Poleyeff indefinitely.

(B) Further, Abraham Poleyeff may petition the Board to hold a Chapter 119. hearing after one year to determine whether or not the Board will consider reinstating his license to practice pharmacy in Ohio. The Board will consider the reinstatement of the license only if Abraham Poleyeff:

(1) takes and successfully completes the Federal Drug Law Exam and the Jurisprudence examination offered by the Board prior to the reinstatement hearing;

(2) does not violate the drug laws of the state of Ohio, any other state, or the federal government;

(3) abides by the rules of the State Board of Pharmacy;
and

(4) complies with the terms of this Order.

Division (B) of Section 4729.16 of the Revised Code provides in pertinent part that: "Any individual whose identification card is revoked, suspended, or refused, shall return his identification card and certificate of registration to the offices of the state board of pharmacy within ten days after receipt of notice of such action." The certificate and identification card should be forwarded by certified mail, return receipt requested.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
