Motion was made and seconded that the following order be adopted.

ORDER

1. The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Ronald E. Swartz was convicted of violation of Section 2907.21 of the Ohio Revised Code and
2. That the renewal of the Pharmacist License of Ronald Swartz be refused until he is released from the Ohio Penitentiary and
3. That, at that time, he be ordered to appear before the State Board of Pharmacy to show cause why his Pharmacist License should not be revoked.

This motion was unanimously approved by a roll call vote of the Board.

ORDER

1. The renewal of the pharmacist license of Ronald E. Swartz be granted and, upon proper application, be issued.
2. Mr. Ronald E. Swartz be required to complete a written examination in jurisprudence.

Mr. John Kern moved approval of the order; Mr. Milton Cohen seconded the motion; members, Gilbert Siegel, James Marshall, Richard Brading voted aye.

The motion was unanimously approved by a roll call vote of the Pharmacy Board.
