
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

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vs

GEORGE C. SELOVER, R.Ph.

THE MATTER OF GEORGE C. SELOVER, DOCKET NO. 6-127-1, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 119. AND 4729. OF THE REVISED CODE ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 4, 1985. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDERFindings Of Fact

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that George C. Selover did not continue his pharmacy education in accordance with the rules of the Board and is not entitled to continue the practice of pharmacy.
- (2) Further, the State Board of Pharmacy notes that:
 - (a) Section 4729.12 of the Revised Code provides, in pertinent part, that: "If the board finds that the applicant ..., has continued his pharmacy education in accordance with the rules of the board, ..., the board shall issue a renewal identification card to the applicant."
 - (b) Paragraph (A) of Rule 4729-7-03 of the Administrative Code provides that: "Registered pharmacists shall keep all certificates and other documented evidence of participation which have been issued for approved C.E.U.'s for which the pharmacist has claimed continuing education units towards renewal of his/her Ohio registered pharmacist identification card for a period of one year following the year in which evidence was required for renewal."

Pursuant to Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the foregoing Findings Of Fact, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby denies George C. Selover's application for renewal of his identification card for the September 15, 1985 through September 14, 1986 licensure year.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
