THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS JAMES L. REPP, DOCKET NO. 6-16-3 WAS CONSIDERED PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729 AND 119, OF THE REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

- (1) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS JAMES L. REPP IS NOT GUILTY OF THE CHARGES (1) AND (2) OF THE CITATION.
- (2) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS JAMES L. REPP IS GUILTY OF CHARGES (3) AND (4), TO WIT: VIOLATION OF SECTION 4729.16 (C), REVISED CODE.
- (3) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16, REVISED CODE, THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 TO 119.13, INCLUSIVE, OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE OR SUSPEND A RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD OR MAY IMPOSE A MONETARY PENALTY OR FORFEITURE IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FIND A PHARMACIST:
 - (D) GUILTY OF PERMITTING ANYONE OTHER THAN A PHARMACIST OR PHARMACY INTERN TO PRACTICE PHARMACY.
- (4) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINES JAMES L. REPP \$50 EACH ON CHARGES (3) AND (4) OF THE CITATION FOR A TOTAL OF \$100.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
