THE MATTER OF MARTHA MOTRIA MACILYNSKY CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON THURSDAY, APRIL 6, 1989 AS A RESULT OF THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD BY HEARING OFFICER AND BOARD MEMBER BETTY NICHOL. FOLLOWING CONSIDERATION OF THE REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION, THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE HEARING, AND EVIDENCE ADDUCED AT THE HEARING, MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Findings Of Fact set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Betty Nichol, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Martha Motria Macilynsky, on or about July 1, 1988, submitted a continuing pharmacy education report form providing evidence of 4.5 CEUs of continuing pharmacy education with her application for renewal of her pharmacist identification card.
- (2) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Martha Motria Macilynsky has not submitted the required proof of continuing pharmacy education as reported on her continuing pharmacy education report form for renewal of her pharmacist identification card.

Conclusion Of Law

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Conclusion Of Law set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Betty Nichol, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraphs (1) and (2) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes dishonesty and unprofessional conduct in the practice of pharmacy.

Action Of The Board

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the recommendation for action set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Betty Nichol. Therefore, pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby takes the following actions concerning the pharmacist license held by Martha Motria Macilynsky:

(A) On the basis of the Conclusion Of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby suspends the pharmacist identification card held by Martha Motria Macilynsky for six months and imposes a monetary penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

(B) Further, the Board will suspend the suspension and the monetary penalty imposed above on condition that Ms. Macilynsky submit all continuing pharmacy education experiences that she has participated in since September 15, 1988 through the hearing date of February 15, 1989, with the understanding that the experiences submitted will not be valid for any future continuing pharmacy education requirements for renewal of her Ohio pharmacist identification card.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
