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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

This Settlement Agreement is entered into by and between David Anthony Spaccarelli and the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy, a state agency charged with enforcing the Pharmacy Practice Act and Dangerous Drug Distribution Act, Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code.

David Anthony Spaccarelli enters into this Agreement being fully informed of his rights afforded under Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, including the right to representation by counsel and the right to a formal adjudication hearing on the issues contained herein.

David Anthony Spaccarelli is knowingly and voluntarily acknowledging that, in order to settle the administrative appeal filed pursuant to the Board's Order by Mr. Spaccarelli in the Hamilton County Common Pleas Court, Case No. A-9305679, David Anthony Spaccarelli enters into this Agreement on the basis of the following stipulations, admissions, and understandings:

1. The Ohio State Board of Pharmacy is empowered by Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code to suspend, revoke, place on probation, refuse to grant or renew an identification card, or impose a monetary penalty on the license holder for violation of any of the enumerated grounds.
2. The matter of David Anthony Spaccarelli came to hearing on April 28, 1993, before the State Board of Pharmacy and the Order of the Board, Docket No. D-921109-027, was mailed on July 1, 1993. Attached hereto and incorporated with this Agreement is the Order of the State Board of Pharmacy, Docket No. D-921109-027, marked as Exhibit A .

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing and mutual promises hereinafter set forth, and in lieu of any formal proceedings at this time, David Anthony Spaccarelli knowingly and voluntarily agrees with the State Board of Pharmacy to the following:

1. David Anthony Spaccarelli's license to practice pharmacy in the state of Ohio will be suspended indefinitely, as of the effective date of this Agreement.
