THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS DAVID E. ALBERT, DOCKET NO. 6-22-2, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTERS 4729 AND 119, REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

- (1) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DAVID E. ALBERT DID VIOLATE SECTION 2925.11 OF THE REVISED CODE AND IS A PHARMACIST WHOSE CONDUCT IS NOT IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTERS 3719 AND 4729, REVISED CODE.
- (2) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DAVID E. ALBERT DID VIOLATE SECTION 2925.22, REVISED CODE, AS CHARGED IN ITEM 2 OF THE CITATION.
- (3) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DAVID E. ALBERT DID VIOLATE SECTION 2925.23, REVISED CODE, AS CHARGED IN ITEM 3 OF THE CITATION.
- (4) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16, REVISED CODE, :  
  
THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 TO 119.13 OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE, SUSPEND, OR REFUSE TO GRANT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER, OR MAY IMPOSE A MONETARY PENALTY OR FORFEITURE NOT TO EXCEED IN SEVERITY ANY FINE DESIGNATED UNDER THE REVISED CODE FOR A SIMILAR OFFENSE, IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FIND A PHARMACIST OR PHARMACY INTERN:  
  
(A) GUILTY OF A FELONY.  
  
(C) GUILTY OF WILLFULLY VIOLATING MORE THAN ONE TIME ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 3715.52 TO 3715.72 OR CHAPTER 2925., 3719., OR 4729. OF THE REVISED CODE.
- (5) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY SUSPENDS THE IDENTIFICATION CARD OF DAVID E. ALBERT FOR TWO YEARS EFFECTIVE JULY 15, 1977 AND SUSPENDS THE SUSPENSION CONTINGENT ON DAVID E. ALBERT COMPLYING WITH ALL STATE AND FEDERAL DRUG LAWS.
- (6) THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY IMPOSES A MONETARY PENALTY OF \$2,500 ON DAVID E. ALBERT.

THIS MOTION WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
