

THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY

VS

DALE M. JONES

THE MATTER OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY VERSUS DALE M. JONES, DOCKET NO. 6-10-3, WAS HEARD PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 119, REVISED CODE. AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE EVIDENCE ADDUCED, MOTION WAS MADE AND RECORDED THE FOLLOWING ORDER BE ADOPTED:

ORDER

1. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 3719.24(A), INFORMATION FOR DELIVERY OF AMPHETAMINE.
2. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 3719.24(A), A DELIVERY OF A BARBITURATE.
3. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 3719.09(A), POSSESSION OF NARCOTIC DRUG.
4. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 3719.24(B), POSSESSION OF AMPHETAMINE.
5. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 3719.24(B), POSSESSION OF BARBITURATE.
6. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(A), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY AND CONVICTED OF VIOLATION OF O.R.C. 4729.51(C), POSSESSION FOR SALE, DANGEROUS DRUG.
7. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS DALE M. JONES DID VIOLATE SECTION 4729.16(C), OHIO REVISED CODE, IN THAT HE HAS BEEN ADJUDGED GUILTY OF WILLFULLY VIOLATING MORE THAN ONE TIME ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 3719.01 to 3719.36, INCLUSIVE, REVISED CODE.
8. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY FINDS UNDER SECTION 4729.16, REVISED CODE, THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, AFTER NOTICE AND HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTIONS 119.01 to 119.13, INCLUSIVE, OF THE REVISED CODE, MAY REVOKE, SUSPEND, OR REFUSE TO GRANT AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER THIS CHAPTER, IF A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FIND A PHARMACIST:
 - (A) GUILTY OF A FELONY.
 - (C) GUILTY OF WILLFULLY VIOLATING MORE THAN ONE TIME ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 3719.01 to 3719.36, INCLUSIVE, REVISED CODE.
9. THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY SUSPENDS THE RENEWAL IDENTIFICATION CARD OF DALE M. JONES FOR ONE YEAR EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 10, 1975.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A ROLL CALL VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

Allegations concerning Dale M. Jones, Docket No. 6-44-2, were considered by the State Board of Pharmacy on May 13, 1981. The records of the State Board of Pharmacy reflect that Dale M. Jones was notified by letter of April 11, 1981 of the allegations against him and of his right to a public hearing, his rights in such a hearing and his right to submit his position, arguments or contentions in writing.
