THE MATTER OF AMER A. MIKATI, DOCKET NO. D-861104-065, CAME ON FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY ON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 1987. MOTIONS WERE MADE AND RECORDED TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

ORDER

Findings Of Fact

- (1) On November 4, 1986, Amer A. Mikati, R.Ph. No. 03-1-14986, was notified by letter of his right to a hearing, his rights in such hearing, and his right to submit his position, contentions, and arguments in writing.
- (2) As demonstrated by return receipt of November 10, 1986, Mr. Mikati received the letter of November 4, 1986 informing him that the Board proposed to deny his application for renewal of his identification card since he had not continued his pharmacy education in accordance with Section 4729.12 of the Revised Code, and Chapter 4729-7 of the Administrative Code.
- (3) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Amer A. Mikati has not requested a hearing in this matter.
- (4) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Amer A. Mikati has not continued his pharmacy education in accordance with Chapter 4729-7 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
- (5) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Amer A. Mikati has not submitted the required 4.5 CEUs needed for renewal of his pharmacist license.

Conclusion Of Law

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (4) and (5) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes failure to meet the requirements for a renewal identification card as set forth in Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Pursuant to Section 4729.12 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the foregoing Findings Of Fact and Conclusion Of Law, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby denies the renewal application for an identification card of Amer A. Mikati.

After fifteen (15) days following the issuance of this Order, you may not engage in the active practice of pharmacy in Ohio, and may not compound or dispense dangerous drugs in Ohio.
