INTRODUCTION

THE MATTER OF MARY ELIZABETH ENZWEILER CAME TO HEARING ON JUNE 28, 1988 BEFORE THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD: NORMAN LEIBOW, R.Ph. (presiding); GERALD CLOUSE, R.Ph.; TIMOTHY MOORE, R.Ph.; BETTY NICHOL, R.Ph.; JOSEPH SABINO, R.Ph.; ROBERT VALENTINE, R.Ph.; JEROME WIESENHAHN, R.Ph.; AND MELVIN WILCZYNSKI, R.Ph.

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FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Mary Elizabeth Enzweiler did compound and dispense drugs between May 21, 1983 and August 20, 1983 at Syncor, Inc., 5225 Creek Road, Blue Ash, Ohio 45242, Terminal Distributor of Dangerous Drugs License No. 02-231600, without being registered as a pharmacist or pharmacy intern pursuant to Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code. Such conduct is prohibited by Section 4729.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

- (2) From the evidence presented, the State Board of Pharmacy finds that Mary Elizabeth Enzweiler did not file with the State of Kentucky the credentials or their equivalent as were then required by the Ohio Board for registration as a pharmacist in 1984, to wit: the 656 hours of practical experience were obtained at Syncor, Inc., 5225 Creek Road, Blue Ash, Ohio 45242, Terminal Distributor of Dangerous Drugs License No. 02-231600, without being registered as a pharmacy intern pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4729. and not in accordance with Chapter 4729-3 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

- (1) Upon consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth in paragraphs (1) and (2) of the Findings Of Fact constitutes violating the provisions of Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code.

ORDER

Pursuant to Section 4729.09 of the Ohio Revised Code, and evidence of mitigating circumstances, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby permits Mary Elizabeth Enzweiler to sit for the reciprocity hearing when it is next offered.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
