Finding Of Fact

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Finding Of Fact set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Gerald Clouse, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy finds that Anne M. Baciewicz did compound and dispense drugs at University Hospitals of Cleveland, 2074 Abbington Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44106, Terminal Distributor of Dangerous Drugs License No. 02-032650, without being registered as a pharmacist or pharmacy intern pursuant to Chapter 4729. of the Ohio Revised Code. This activity was done on the following dates:

Such conduct is prohibited by Section 4729.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Conclusion Of Law

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the Conclusion Of Law set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Gerald Clouse, as follows:

- (1) The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that the conduct set forth above in the Finding Of Fact constitutes violations of the provisions of Section 4729.28 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Action Of The Board

The State Board of Pharmacy hereby agrees with and adopts the recommendation for action set forth in the Report and Recommendation of Hearing Officer and Board Member Gerald Clouse. Therefore, pursuant to Section 4729.16 of the Ohio Revised Code, the State Board of Pharmacy takes the following actions concerning the matter of Anne Marian Baciewicz:

(A) On the basis of the Conclusion Of Law set forth above, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby imposes a monetary penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

(B) Further, the Board suspends four hundred dollars of the monetary penalty imposed in paragraph (A) above, and permits Anne Marian Baciewicz to sit for reciprocity at the next scheduled hearing.

The one hundred dollar (\$100.00) monetary penalty that was not suspended in paragraph (B) above is due and owing within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this Order. Said monetary penalty should be made payable to the "Treasurer, State of Ohio" and mailed to the State Board of Pharmacy, 65 S. Front Street, Room 504, Columbus, Ohio 43266-0320, with the enclosed form.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY.
