FINDINGS OF FACT

After having heard the testimony, observed the demeanor of the witnesses, considered the evidence, and weighed the credibility of each, the State Board of Pharmacy finds the following to be fact:

- (1) Records of the Board of Pharmacy indicate that RajaManikandan Bhojaraj applied to the Board for registration as an intern in the State of Ohio on July 8, 2005.
- (2) RajaManikandan Bhojaraj is not of good moral character and habits within the meaning of Rule 4729-5-04 of the Ohio Administrative Code, to wit: RajaManikandan Bhojaraj was, on or about May 27, 2005, convicted of Criminal Confinement and Battery, misdemeanors in the State of Indiana. State of Indiana vs. RajaManikandan Bhojaraj, Cause No. 79D05-0503-FD-00109, Superior Court No. 5 of Tippecanoe County. RajaManikandan Bhojaraj served a term of incarceration and he was placed on probation.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The State Board of Pharmacy concludes that paragraph (2) of the Findings of Fact constitutes not being of good moral character and habits as set forth in paragraph (C) of Rule 4729-5-04 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

DECISION OF THE BOARD

Pursuant to Section 4729.11 of the Ohio Revised Code, and after consideration of the record as a whole, the State Board of Pharmacy hereby approves the Application for Pharmacy Intern Registration submitted by RajaManikandan Bhojaraj on July 8, 2005.

THIS ORDER WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY (Aye-7/Nay-0).

Any other order may be appealed to the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County, Ohio.

Such an appeal, setting forth the order appealed from and the grounds of the appeal, must be commenced by filing the original Notice of Appeal with the State Board of Pharmacy and a copy with the appropriate court within fifteen (15) days after the mailing of this Order and in accordance with the requirements of Section 119.12 of the Ohio Revised Code.
