



## 2017 WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR RENEWAL GUIDANCE

### **Third-Party Logistics Providers (3PL) & Virtual Wholesalers/Manufacturers**

As a Third-Party Logistics Provider (3PL) or Virtual Wholesaler/Manufacturer you are required to possess a current and valid license in the state in which the entity is located. If your state does not license your entity, then you must obtain verified-accredited wholesale distributors (VAWD) accreditation from the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP). [Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 4729-9-28(C) and 4729-9-29(C), effective April 1, 2016]

Prior to renewing you are required to submit one of the following:

- A valid state license to distribute dangerous drugs in the state in which the entity is physically located; or
- A certificate of VAWD Accreditation provided by NABP; or
- A VAWD Accreditation Extension for One-Time Renewal Request with proof of submitted application to NABP. The form may be found here - <http://www.pharmacy.ohio.gov/Licensing/WDDD.aspx#>
