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### Reminder: DEA Guidance on Oral CII Prescriptions

DEA is aware that during this pandemic there are obstacles to practitioners meeting with their existing patients and providing these patients with written prescriptions for schedule II controlled substances. As a result, practitioners and pharmacists have asked DEA to clarify the circumstances under which oral schedule II prescriptions are permitted. DEA has issued guidance on this topic and has also announced temporary exceptions.
