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#### STATE OF OHIO BOARD OF PHARMACY



A Tool for Law Enforcement & Regulatory Agencies The Shared Prescription Investigation Deconfliction Resource (SPIDR) is designed to prevent overlapping investigations of pharmaceutical drug violations. Access is limited to law enforcement agencies and administrative agencies that regulate prescribers, pharmacists, and pharmacies.

The tool is being offered at no cost to partner agencies by the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy.

Agencies may apply for an unlimited number of accounts.

#### **How it works**

An agency enters limited amounts of data about an investigation into the web -based database, and the database informs them if any other investigations seem to match. If a match is found, all the affected investigators will be notified to contact each other.

### Confidentiality

No sensitive information is entered into or stored by the database. Further, the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy does not perform searches of the data. Conflict detection is completely automated and all conflict messages are transmitted securely via email or text, at the user's direction.

# Special Note For Law Enforcement

Recognizing that some investigations are sensitive, database creators included an added layer of protection.

Users can designate individual cases "Law Enforcement Only." If such a case triggers a conflict, only affected law enforcement users will be notified.
