HB73 AUTHORIZE PRESCRIBING OFF-LABEL DRUGS (GROSS J, LOYCHIK M) To authorize the prescribing of off-label drugs and if prescribed, to require their dispensing and to name this act the Dave and Angie Patient and Health Provider Protection Act.

HB80 PHARMACIST CARE (LIPPS S) Regarding pharmacist care.

SAVE OHIO SAFE RX (YOUNG T, SANTUCCI N) To establish the Canadian Prescription Drug Importation Program, to name this act the Save Ohio Safe Rx Act, and to make an appropriation.
