1) Ohio Department of Health – Wholesale Distributor of Dangerous Drugs Extension*

**This approval was authorized by the Board President pursuant to resolution R-2022-0128 on 7/24/22.*

In order to address storage capacity at your existing warehouse and to promote the safe distribution of COVID-19 vaccines, the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy temporarily authorizes the Ohio Department of Health to store non-controlled dangerous drugs maintained at its Board of Pharmacy-licensed locations at its storage facility at 6480 Adelaide Ct., Groveport, Ohio 43125 (e.g. Adelaide Facility).

In authorizing the temporary storage of dangerous drugs at this location, the Ohio Department of Health shall ensure that the Adelaide Facility complies with all applicable requirements for wholesale distributors set forth in chapter 4729 of the Revised Code and chapters 4729:6-5 and 4729:6-3 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

This authorization is being issued in accordance with a Board resolution adopted on May 5, 2020 and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2023 but may be extended by the Board at the request of the Department.
