Rule for Pharmacist Feedback – Prohibition on the Use of Quotas (Comments Due 11.9.2022)

In 2020 and 2021, the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy issued workload surveys to Ohio licensed pharmacists. These surveys formed the basis for the creation of the Board's [Pharmacist Workload Advisory Committee](#) (PWAC).

The PWAC began meeting in October 2021 to review the survey data and present a menu of options for consideration by the Board.

As a result of the work of the Committee and feedback from the pharmacist community, the Board is proposing the adoption of a rule to prohibit the use of quotas in the operation of a pharmacy.

Comments on the proposed rule are due by close of business on **November 9, 2022**.
