## Ohio Board of Pharmacy Now Offers an Online Review and Quiz for Reciprocity

The Ohio Board of Pharmacy now offers a convenient online review and quiz for out-of-state pharmacists applying for licensure via reciprocity. The Board's Reciprocity Review and Quiz is designed to provide applicants with critical knowledge on the laws and rules governing the practice of pharmacy. It is designed in two parts.

1. First, applicants review all 16 law and rule review videos and familiarize themselves with the guidance documents referenced in each video. This should take approximately 60-75 minutes.
2. Next, applicants will be required to successfully complete a scored quiz component. To pass the quiz, you must obtain a score of 75% (12 out of 16 questions). You ONLY have three attempts to pass this quiz. Failure to pass the quiz within three attempts will result in your application being abandoned and application fee forfeited. In addition, you only have six months to complete the review and quiz before your application is deemed abandoned and application fee forfeited.

The Reciprocity Review and Quiz replaces the monthly reciprocity review offered by the Board. This new feature will allow pharmacists to complete the required review of Ohio law and rules at their convenience.

To access the Reciprocity Review and Quiz, the Board's Licensing Department will send an email with instructions once the reciprocity applicant has submitted all of the required application materials. Please be advised that the Reciprocity Review and Quiz are the last steps in the reciprocity process and cannot be accessed without a completed application.
