

COVID-19 Vaccine for Ages 5-11 - ODH Releases Updated Resources for Providers

COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 5-11 can begin as quickly as possible now that the federal review and authorization process is complete.

On November 2nd, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended use of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine pediatric formulation for children ages 5-11 following a thorough review of the vaccine's safety and effectiveness.

As a reminder, COVID-19 vaccines may be administered by qualifying pharmacy personnel to children in this age group. To assist licensees, the Board has issued the following guidance on the administration of COVID-19 vaccinations under state and federal law (e.g. PREP Act):
