

In-State and Non-Resident Nuclear Pharmacy Rules Effective 2/1/2022

Effective February 1, 2022, new in-state and non-resident nuclear pharmacy rules go into effect.

To assist licensees in complying with these rules, the Board developed the following guidance documents:

- Requirements for Ohio Nuclear Pharmacies

Licensees are strongly encouraged to review these guidance materials and the rule text. Links to the new rules are included in each document.

Ohio institutional facilities with on-site nuclear pharmacies are required to submit notification to the Board to comply with the new rules. For more information on these notification requirements, click here.

REMINDER: These rules do not apply to prescribers engaged in the preparation, preparation with minor deviation, compounding, dispensing, personally furnishing, or repackaging of radiopharmaceuticals. NOTE: Ohio prescribers are required to comply with Chapter 3701:1-58 of the Administrative Code.

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
