



## Pharmacist Continuing Education Project with Assistance to Facilitate Protocol Implementation to Address Nicotine Use Disorder

<u>Rule 4729:1-3-07</u>, which became effective on May 6, 2022, provides the standards for dispensing nicotine replacement therapy by pharmacists pursuant to a physician-approved protocol. Through the creation of a continuing education course, the Nicotine Recovery Unit, situated in the Ohio Department of Health Tobacco Use Prevention and Cessation Program, is interested in working with an agency in the pharmacy community to create awareness of this rule, provide support for implementation in pharmacy settings, and work to increase reach in communities most in need of assistance to address their tobacco/nicotine dependence.
